## General Update - Cumulative


- Total number of confirmed cases:
   12,611
- Total number of cases last 14 days:
   1,368
- Total negative results:
   127,949
- Total number of individuals tested:
   140,560

- Total number of deaths: <u>171</u>
  - LTCF deaths: 111(65% of total deaths)
  - Non-LTCF deaths: 60(35% of total deaths)
- Presumed Recovered: 9,853



## General Update - Key Metrics


- Number of Cases in the past two weeks:
  - Week of 10/4: 640 (91/day)
  - Week of 9/27: 673 (96/day)




- Incidence Rate (last 14 days): 227/100,000
- 14-day percent positive: 6.1%




Percent Positivity Rate - calculated using an individuals first new positive result divided by the total number of all individuals tested in the last 14 days.




#### MARC Region

 Hospital metrics in Johnson County continue to trend well.



## Schools

 JCDHE School Team is working with districts on several positive cases - most are community exposure
