SUBJECT: Coronavirus Relief Fund Reimbursement – Phase 3

The following nonprofit organization (KCFPF) and a Kansas charitable health care provider (MTMM) have submitted a request for reimbursement of payments from the Johnson County Government for federal funds appropriated pursuant to section 601 of the Social Security Act, as added by section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, Pub. L. No. 116-136, div. A, Title V (Mar. 27, 2020).

These programs and expenditures have been reviewed by Treasury & Financial Management staff experienced with Grant reporting and the Witt O'Brien's consulting firm knowledgeable of the CRF regulation guidelines, and are recommended for approval. The requesting Organization(s) have provided sufficient supporting documentation to demonstrate that the expenditure of funds requested is in accordance with section 601(d) of the Social Security Act.

The Organization(s) have acknowledged that the expenditures requested were not accounted for in the budget most recently approved as of March 27, 2020, were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020 and ends on December 30, 2020; and will not be used to replace or supplant any other funding nor to fill or prevent revenue shortages.
