
Dear Commissioners:

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Spring Hill, Kansas (the “City”), will hold a public hearing at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as possible, on Thursday, December 14, 2023, at the Spring Hill Civic Center, 401 N. Madison Street, Spring Hill, Kansas, for the purpose of considering a five-year extension to an existing exemption from *ad valorem* taxes on property used exclusively by a business for manufacturing articles of commerce pursuant to Article 11, Section 13 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas and K.S.A. 79-251. Interested members of the public are invited to attend the public hearing and express their views orally or in writing on the proposed extension of the existing tax exemption.
