

Purpose

- Objectively assess resident priorities and satisfaction with county services
- Measure trends over time
- Compare the County's performance with regional and national norms

Methodology

Survey Description

- Survey took most people about 10-15 minutes to complete
- The survey contained many questions from the 2020 Resident Survey

Administration

- By mail, email, and text to a random sample of residents in each of the County's 6 commission districts
- At total of 1,649 residents completed the survey with at least 200-300 respondents from each commission district

Margin of Error


• +/-2.4% at the 95% level of confidence







by percentage of residents surveyed (three selections could be made)



Q5. Primary Reasons For Living in Johnson County 2020 vs. 2022



by percentage of residents surveyed who selected the item as one of their top three choices



by percentage of residents surveyed who rated the item as a 4 or 5 on a 5-point scale (excluding "don't knows")





by percentage of respondents who rated the item 4 or 5 on a 5-point scale where 5 was "excellent" and 1 was "poor" (excluding don't knows)



Perceptions of Life in the Community Johnson County vs. U.S. vs. Large Communities















by percentage of residents surveyed







Summary

Satisfaction with County Services Has Increased in Most Areas

Johnson County is Setting the Standard for the Delivery of Most County Services

Since 2020, the priority for Public Works and Motor Vehicle Services Has Declined While the Priority for Public Health Services Has Increased

The Reasons Residents Are Coming to Johnson County and the Reasons They Plan to Stay in Johnson County Did Not Change Significantly as a Result of the Pandemic

Residents Are Significantly More Likely to Think It is "Very Important" for the County to Provide Safety-Net Services for Low Income Residents Compared to Two Years Ago
